

**NAME**

`extconv` – convert a TeX document in either Big 5+ or GBK encoding into ‘preprocessed’ form.

**SYNOPSIS**

`extconv <infile> >outfile`

**DESCRIPTION**

Big 5+ and GBK encodings use the characters {, }, and \ which have special meanings in TeX documents.

After processing a L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X 2<sub>ε</sub> document which contains such characters with `extconv` you need not care about these special characters.

This filter is part of the **CJK** macro package for L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X 2<sub>ε</sub>.
