GTTY (II)

NAME

`gty` — get typewriter status

SYNOPSIS

```
(gty = 32.)  
(file descriptor in r0)  
sys gty; arg  
...  
arg: . = . +6  
gty(fildes, arg)  
int arg[3];
```

DESCRIPTION

Gty stores in the three words addressed by *arg* the status of the typewriter whose file descriptor is given in *r0* (resp. given as the first argument). The format is the same as that passed by *stty*.

DIAGNOSTICS

Error bit (c-bit) is set if the file descriptor does not refer to a typewriter. From C, a `-1` value is returned for an error, `0`, for a successful call.
