The IBM Series/1 Event Driven Executive Macro Library (5719-LM5) is a set of macros that can be installed and used on the Series/1 so that application programs written in the Event Driven Language and the Series/1 instruction set can be assembled using the IBM Series/1 Event Driven Executive Macro Assembler (5719-ASA).

- IBM Series/1 Event Driven Executive Macro Library (5719-LM5) requires 13,000 256-byte records on a Series/1 direct access storage device

Programs created with IBM Series/1 Event Driven Executive Macro Library (5719-LM5) are intended to execute on a Series/1 and will require the IBM Series/1 Event Driven Executive Basic Supervisor and Emulator (5719-XS1). Depending on the functions used in your application, additional licensed programs may be required.

The IBM Series/1 Event Driven Executive Utilities (5719-UT3) is required to install the IBM Series/1 Event Driven Executive Macro Library (5719-LM5).
